

Provisional Timetable for Mapping Environmental Assets, starting June 2024

Course starts: Monday 3rd June 2024

Course duration: 6 weeks, part-time, with taught sessions across the first 5 weeks.

The course is taught across 6 weeks via a series of 1-hour online evening sessions, three in-person workshops at University of Cumbria's Ambleside Campus, and two half-day farm visits. This is followed by further time for independent work to complete an assessed task.

Please check your emails and follow the instructions to complete your account set up with University of Cumbria ready to access the first online session. Sessions not specified as online will be in-person only. For Farm Visits the group will meet at the farms. Travel is not included; personal transport will be required.
