<p>All students need to be aware that they will incur additional costs whilst on programme. Books and Journals	
<p>The study of literary texts hardly requires textbooks; instead students focus on the intensive study of a large number of primary texts. On average, if a student bought each text new the cost over the three years of the programme would be c. £284. Kindle editions would be cheaper still. Many older texts are in the public domain and are available free via internet repositories or the UoC library. In addition, there is a thriving second hand market in literary works and a student could certainly cut costs by acquiring texts second-hand.</p>	
Stationery	
<p>Students will incur costs for stationery and printing and other basic materials whilst on course and should budget accordingly. Where specifics are required they will be detailed below but items denoted are an outline rather than indicative list. Stationery for your own personal use (pens, papers and folders, etc.) Whilst you will choose how much you need, expect to pay around £10 - £20 per year for these.
