<b>Additional Costs</b>	
<p>All students need to be aware that they will incur additional costs whilst on programme. The list below will provide you with an overview of additional costs.</p> <p>Books are reviewed annually and are therefore subject to change, course welcome information will provide you with an indicative list for the year.</p>	
<b>Books and Journals</b>	
<p>The University library holds copies of core texts (including some as eBooks accessible online). However, students may wish to purchase their own copies, in which case the following are recommended (although reviewed each year). Recommended Core Text: Bryant R. Bryant S (2015) Blackstones Handbook for Policing students. Oxford University Press £30 - £35</p>	
<b>Stationery</b>	
<p><b>EXAMPLE:</b> Stationery for your own personal use (pens, papers and folders, etc.).</p> <p>Whilst you will choose how much you need, expect to pay around £30 - £40 per year for these.</p>	
<b>Clothing and Equipment</b>	
<p>Students will incur costs for stationery and printing and other basic materials whilst on course and should budget accordingly. Where specifics are required, they will be detailed below but items denoted are an outline rather than indicative list. Stationery for your own personal use (pens, papers and folders, etc.) Whilst you will choose how much you need, expect to pay around £10 - £20 per year for these.</p>

<b>Other</b>	
<p>Those Policing students (both BSc and FdSc) who apply and are selected for a Special Constabulary placement opportunity will be required to buy their own boots (Police Uniform standard) as these are not supplied as part of the scaled uniform issue. The cost of an appropriate type and style of boot for use on Police duty is between £50 and £120. Once confirmed as a Special Constable, the students will be able to claim this cost back, to a maximum of £80.00. Those students who undertake a placement may also incur initial travel costs to and from Police HQ at Penrith, at the start of their formal training period. The costs will relate directly to the distance travelled and mode of transport used. Again, once a student is confirmed as Special Constable, they are able to claim back their travel and subsistence expenses. Those students undertaking a placement are fully briefed on these matters at an early stage of the BSc/FdSc.</p>
