

Cumbria International PGT Scholarship

Terms and Conditions

These terms and conditions apply to the Cumbria International PGT Scholarship offered at University of Cumbria only.

Summary

- Total value of scholarship: £2,000
- Deadline for all conditions to be met: 19th August 2026 (16th December 2026 for programme starting in January 2027)
- Deadline for relevant deposits to be paid: 19th August 2026 (16th December 2026 for programme starting in January 2027)
- Scholarships will be automatically deducted from the tuition fees on registration at the University of Cumbria
- There is no cash alternative for the award.
- This award cannot be held in conjunction with any other university awards or discounts
- The university retains the right to withdraw this scholarship, at any time prior to 19th August 2026

Eligible Postgraduate programmes

International applicants holding an offer for the following postgraduate programmes **may be eligible** for the Cumbria International PGT Scholarship:

- Any taught master's programme delivered full-time in person on the Ambleside Campus
- Any taught master's programme delivered full-time in person on the Carlisle Campus (both Brampton Road and Fusehill)
- Any taught master's programme delivered full-time in person on the Lancaster Campus

The following postgraduate programmes **are not eligible** for the Cumbria International PGT Scholarship:

- MBA Master of Business Administration (London Campus)
- MBA Master of Business Administration (Lancaster Campus)
- MBA Tourism and Visitor Economy Management (Ambleside Campus)
- Postgraduate Pre-Registration Health Courses
- All PG Diploma Awards
- All PG Certificate Awards
- All PGT programmes delivered by distance, blended or part-time learning
- All PGT programmes delivered in collaboration with an educational partner
- All PG Research programmes

Note: Students progressing onto postgraduate programmes at University of Cumbria, from the International College, will be considered eligible for the International Postgraduate Scholarship providing all eligibility criteria have been met.

Other Eligibility Criteria

1. To be eligible for the Cumbria International PGT Scholarship, applicants must hold an offer of a place of study on an **eligible full-time master's programme** (180 credits) at Ambleside, Carlisle (Brampton Road), Carlisle (Fusehill Street) or Lancaster Campus.
2. Only applicants with an offer of a place in September 2026 or January 2027 will be considered for the award.
3. For students enrolling on programmes lasting more than one year the scholarship is awarded **for the first year of the programme only** as a fee reduction.
4. All applicants must be self-funding students with **overseas fee status**.

5. All offer holders must be holding, or on track to be awarded, the equivalent of a minimum of a UK 2:2 bachelor's degree will be considered for an award

Applying for the Cumbria International PGT Scholarship

- There is no need to apply for this scholarship, if the applicant is eligible, the award will be automatically applied to reduce the tuition fee payable.

Eligible award holders

1. Scholarships can only be taken during the 2026/27 academic year and cannot be deferred to any other period
2. Scholarships will not be awarded to applicants in receipt of a scholarship from any other source.
3. Published tuition fees apply to the stated academic year only and may be subject to inflationary increases in subsequent years of study.
4. This scholarship cannot be combined with any other scholarship or discount and, if a successful applicant is offered more than one University of Cumbria award, only the award of the greater amount will be granted.
5. Should a successful candidate transfer programme, the scholarship may no longer be valid and may be withdrawn.
6. Should a successful candidate withdraw/suspend from a programme of study the student will be liable to pay tuition fees in accordance with the university's tuition fee policy.
7. All successful scholarship holders will be invited to support the university with appropriate internationalisation events and provide a photograph and statement to be included in our publicity.
8. The University of Cumbria retains the right to withdraw the scholarship in the following circumstances:
 - a. It is subsequently found that the candidate is ineligible for the scholarship, for example if the candidate has not met the entry requirements or the terms and conditions of this award.
 - b. Documentation used to apply to a programme at the university are subsequently found to be fraudulent.
 - c. Tuition fees are not paid in accordance with the terms and conditions of this award and/or the university's tuition fee policy.
 - d. The university suspends or withdraws an eligible programme of study for 2026/27 entry
