Peekaboo!






What a good view of the River Lune. On a clear day you can see the Ashton Memorial in Lancaster, I think a giant lives in there!



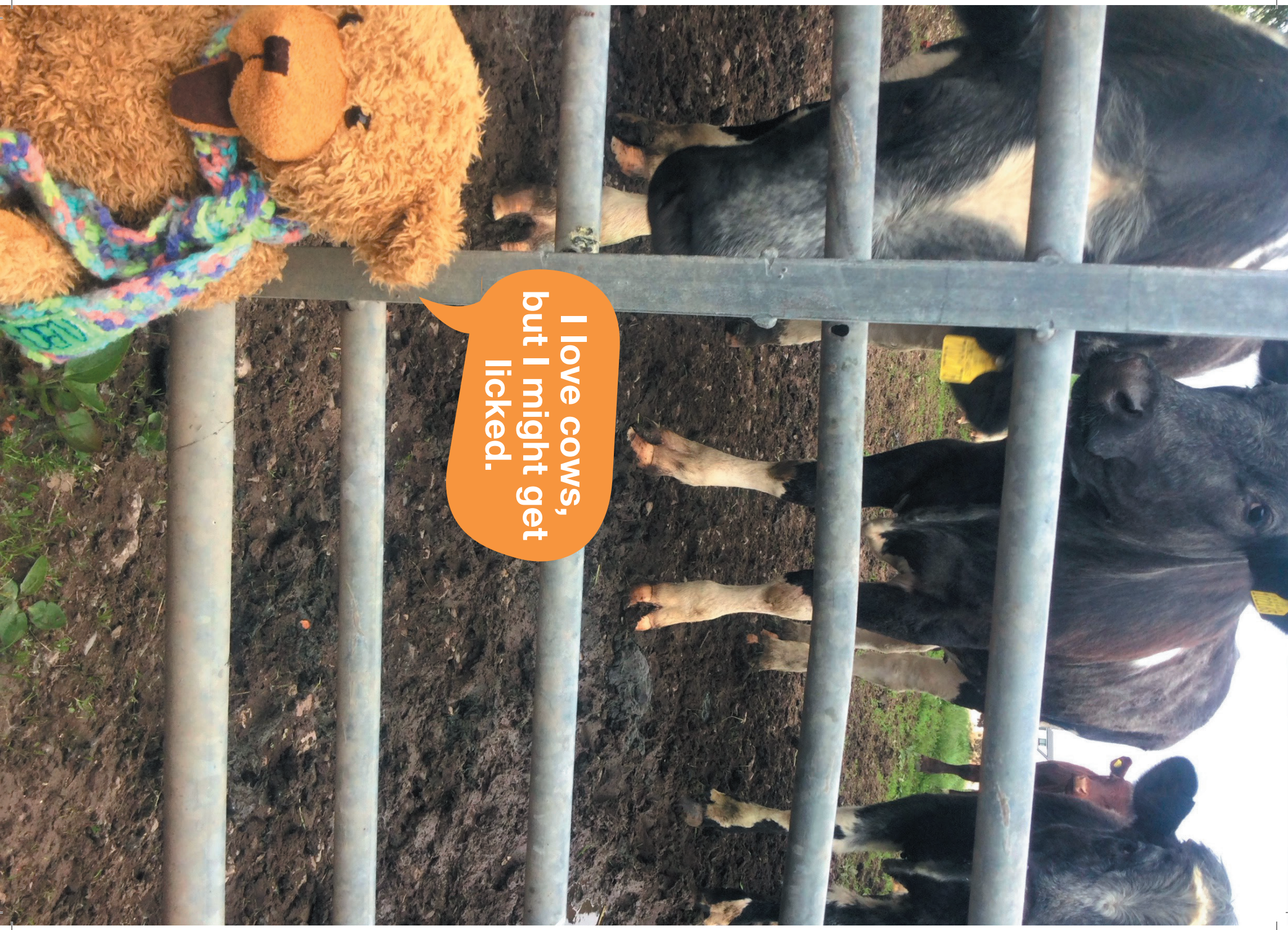

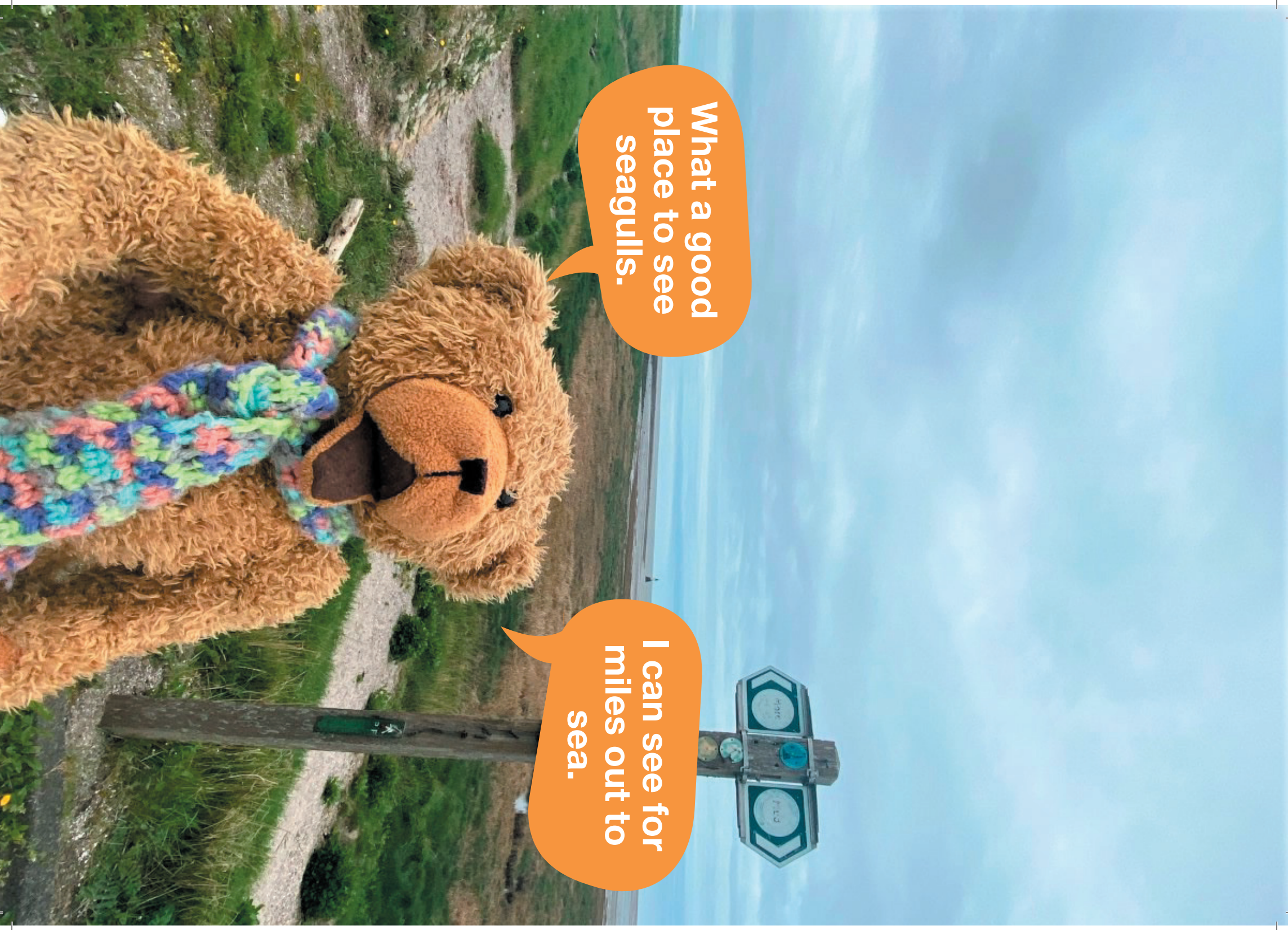

I wonder what anchors were used for? Was it for catching fish?

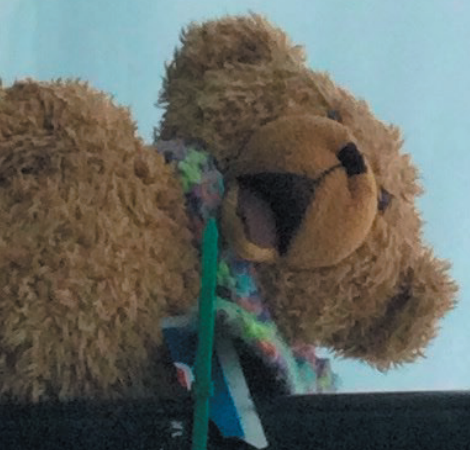






I like it in here because bears like fish.
