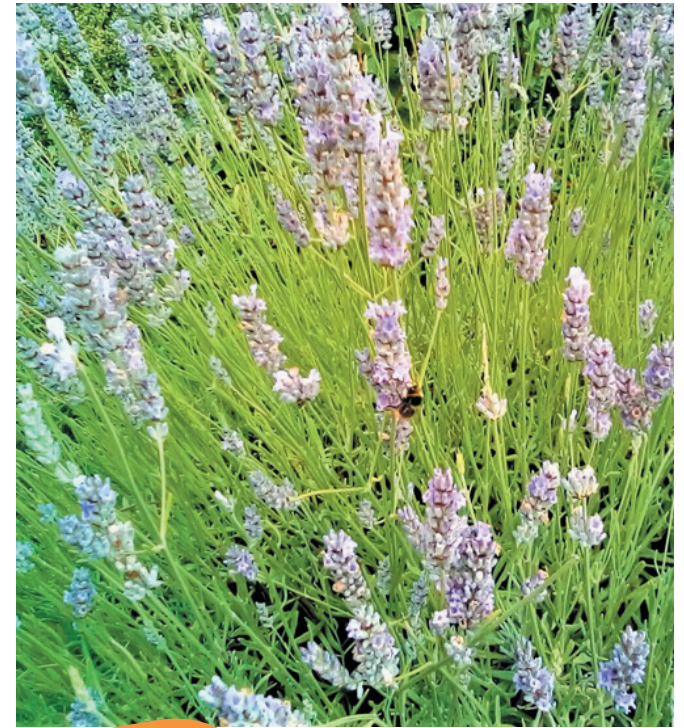

Look, a curlew and an oystercatcher.





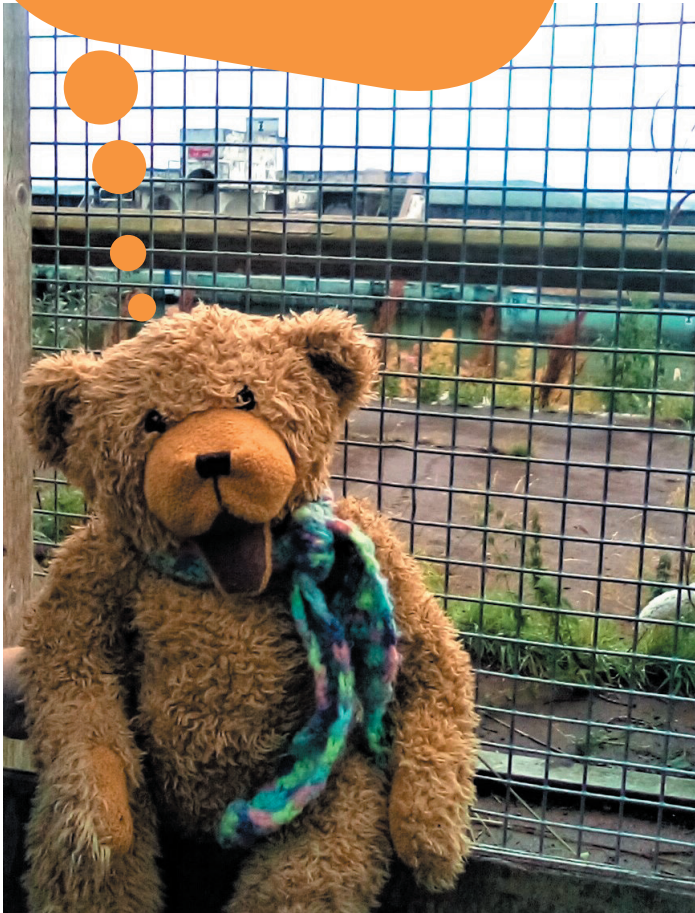
