a long way.




I like all the

I'd love to have a ride in that boat.



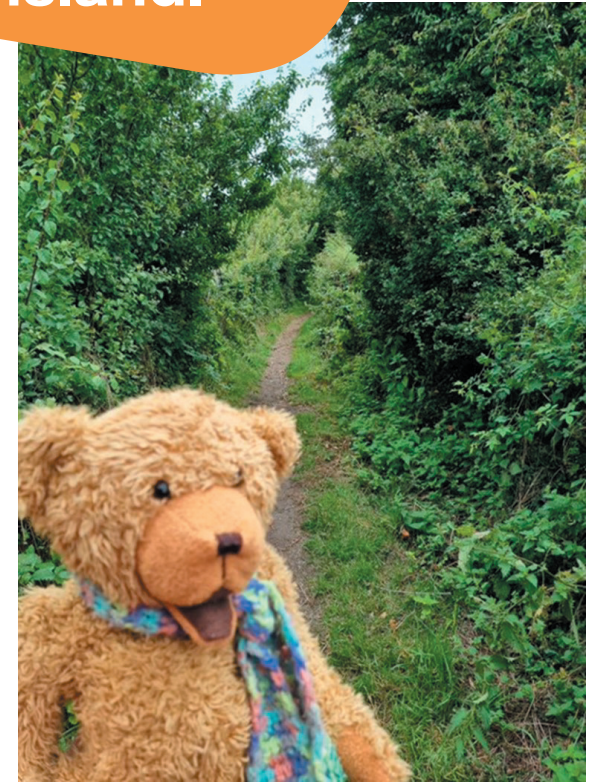
Peekaboo!

a snack.

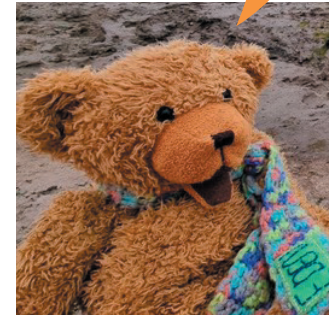



Time for
