



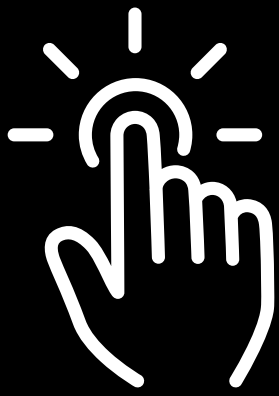

congratulations on your achievements.

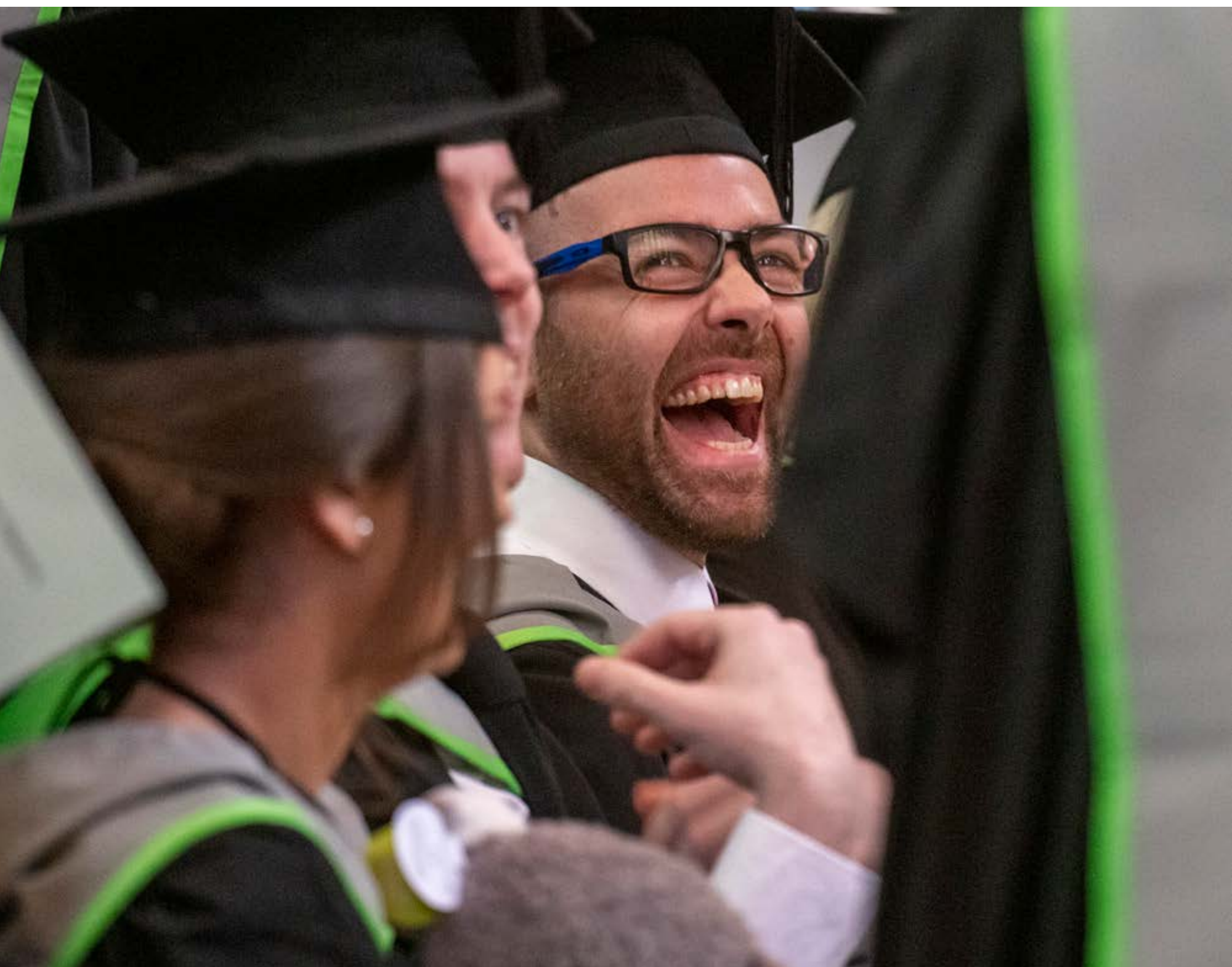

REFLECTION 24/25

Our university, in, for and beyond Cumbria, was established 18 years ago to transform lives and livelihoods through learning, applied research and practice for now and generations to come.

We have a broad geographic footprint, with campuses in Ambleside, Barrow, Carlisle, Lancaster and London.

We support 1,000 staff and over 20,000 students who study on campus, in the workplace and online - across Cumbria, throughout the UK and in more than 189 countries worldwide. Around 1,800 of these students are based here in Carlisle.

BAE Systems, Sellafield Ltd, NHS trusts, police forces, schools, and the Forestry Commission are just some of the proud partners of our university. Working with us, they support us to inspire and equip our graduates, communities, economy and environment to thrive.



Working in partnership, as a member of the Police Education Consortium, we provide Police Constable Degree Apprenticeships and Degree Holder Entry Programmes to new police recruits for and beyond Surrey, Sussex, Hampshire and Thames Valley constabularies.

We draw on our practice and applied research base, people, distinctive locations, environment, landscapes and partners to build capability for the county and localities we serve, exporting our expertise beyond geographical boundaries. Our university has a strong base of experts across our academic institutes including research and knowledge exchange. We were recognised in the Knowledge Excellence Framework for having high engagement in local growth and regeneration and development income.

KEY MILESTONES

It is an exciting time for our university and for Cumbria.

In Carlisle, we continue to work with our partners - Cumberland Council and Borderlands Inclusive Growth Deal leaders - to advance our plans for our new £78 million Citadels campus.



Our new Barrow campus opened in September, which symbolises the growth plans for the town that we and our partners - including Brilliant Barrow and Team Barrow - are driving forward. We are now delivering degree-level programmes in mechanical engineering, computer science and adult nursing - with more to follow. At a time of significant transformation, shaping the future of Barrow into a university town provides considerable opportunities for the wider region.

In August we welcomed students to Cumbria's first graduate-entry medical school, the Pears Cumbria School of Medicine (PCSM), a unique partnership between University of Cumbria and Imperial College London.

The four-year, graduate-entry programme features a bespoke curriculum aligned with local healthcare planning and infrastructure, ensuring students gain the skills needed to contribute meaningfully to the NHS and their communities.

PCSM is also building a foundation for research that addresses regional health challenges and improves patient outcomes. PCSM is the result of a shared vision to educate medical professionals to serve communities in regions with the greatest need.





The University of Cumbria International College opened to students in September. It offers a number of foundation, international year one and pre-master's programmes from our Lancaster campus. International College students will then progress to our existing programmes across all campuses and will help bring a new generation of international students to Cumbria.

The opening of our Barrow site, medical school and International College, alongside the work being undertaken in Carlisle, are all key milestones in our university's strategy, purpose and mission alongside our growth and development during our 18-year journey to date.

As we look forward, we will continue to transform lives and livelihoods through learning, applied research and practice for now and for our future generations.



OUR SUCCESSES



Jack Brennand, Postgraduate Research Associate

Jack Brennand originally completed his BSc (Hons) Geography degree with the University of Cumbria in 2020 before embarking on his doctoral studies, completing his PhD in spring 2025.

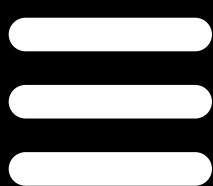
Over this period, Jack worked with Cumbrian-based environmental company Barker & Bland Ltd to evaluate the effectiveness of UK-based blanket peatland restoration. As part of this Innovate UK-funded Knowledge Transfer Partnership research,



they examined the sub-surface impacts of restoration, which is rarely considered in surface monitoring protocols, and created an innovative carbon calculator which has been adopted by the International Union of Conservation and Nature UK Peatland Project for use in the UK Peatland Code. It helps peatland restoration projects to calculate their direct greenhouse gas emissions associated with their activities, allowing for more exact climate benefits to be forecast.

Jack also joined the University of Cumbria staff team as a Teaching Associate, sharing his skills and knowledge with new students. He now works as a postgraduate research associate in the North West.

“I’m really proud of the work I’ve produced. I’ve been able to collaborate with so many wonderful people and been able to research in some state-of-the-art facilities, which I never thought I’d do. And what’s important is that this research gives hope. It can be difficult talking about climate change and I remember through my lectures when I was an undergraduate at the University of Cumbria that my tutor Simon Carr would always end a session with a slide of positive news which I think is really valuable and one day I hope this can be the positive news at the end of the slides.”





Bin Sun, Explorer and high-altitude mountain guide,
Summit Experience

With over 29 years' experience of mountaineering around the globe, Bin Sun chose to return to learning to deepen his knowledge, completing his PhD in spring 2025.

He relocated from his native China to study at our Ambleside campus in the heart of England's Lake District, graduating from the MA Outdoor and Experiential Learning programme in 2024.

Months afterwards he led an expedition to Antarctica and the South Pole, taking with him one of his most prized possessions – our university's unofficial mascot 'Little Herdy'.

Bin said: "After decades in the field, I wanted to reflect more deeply on the 'why' behind outdoor experiences - not just the summits - but how we learn, grow, and transform through nature.



“The MA Outdoor and Experiential Learning programme was the perfect fit. It helped me bridge my field experience with academic reflection, pedagogy, and a global perspective. Ambleside felt like home from the very beginning.

“This programme has given me the language and framework to better design learning experiences in the outdoors. It has elevated my work from guiding to facilitating personal growth and environmental awareness. I now train aspiring guides and design international outdoor learning programmes that blend Chinese and Western approaches. My studies gave me both renewed purpose and professional depth.

“Every gram matters in Antarctica and we had tight limits on weight and what could be taken. With extreme temperatures too, we had to carefully choose what came with us but for me it had to be Little Herdy.

“Little Herdy represents more than a mascot - it symbolised my time at Ambleside, the values of community, curiosity, and connection to nature. Taking Herdy with me was my personal way of bringing the University of Cumbria spirit to the ends of the Earth. And what better way to celebrate my graduation than to carry my university to the top of Antarctica and the geographic South Pole?”





Kian Orchard, Degree Co-ordinator, Carlisle United Community Sports Trust

Kian was raised and educated in rural north west Cumbria. Applying to the University of Cumbria through Clearing, Kian graduated in July 2025 after successfully completing his three-year BSc (Hons) Sport Coaching and Physical Education degree delivered at our Lancaster campus.



Using his graduate skills, Kian is now inspiring future generations of young people with Carlisle United's Community Sports Trust (CUCST). Having originally volunteered and worked in a coaching capacity during his time as a student, Kian is now employed as Degree Co-ordinator supporting the Trust's higher education students.

He said: "It's exciting to be in this new role and to have the chance to be giving something back. I'm incredibly grateful to Carlisle United and the Community Sports Trust for giving me the opportunity to develop and continue my journey with them. Before starting this new role, I was already doing lots of work with the Community Sports Trust delivering in Primary School Programmes like the Premier League's Primary Stars and help lead community sports sessions."

"I'm grateful for where the University of Cumbria has taken me. I've really enjoyed my course, and my tutors were invaluable. I had quite an unorthodox route to where I am now, and it really does demonstrate the range of options and choices that are available to you."





Sophie Steadman, Graduate Artist in Residence

After graduating in 2023 with a degree in Fine Art, Sophie has co-founded SoMo, an artist collaborative project, with a fellow Fine Art graduate. SoMo aims to provide and promote opportunities for Cumbrian artists including current and former students at our Institute of Education, Arts and Society. More recently, Sophie has just returned from the trip of a lifetime after being part of an artistic collective to exhibit at the world's biggest art festival – The 60th Venice Biennale.

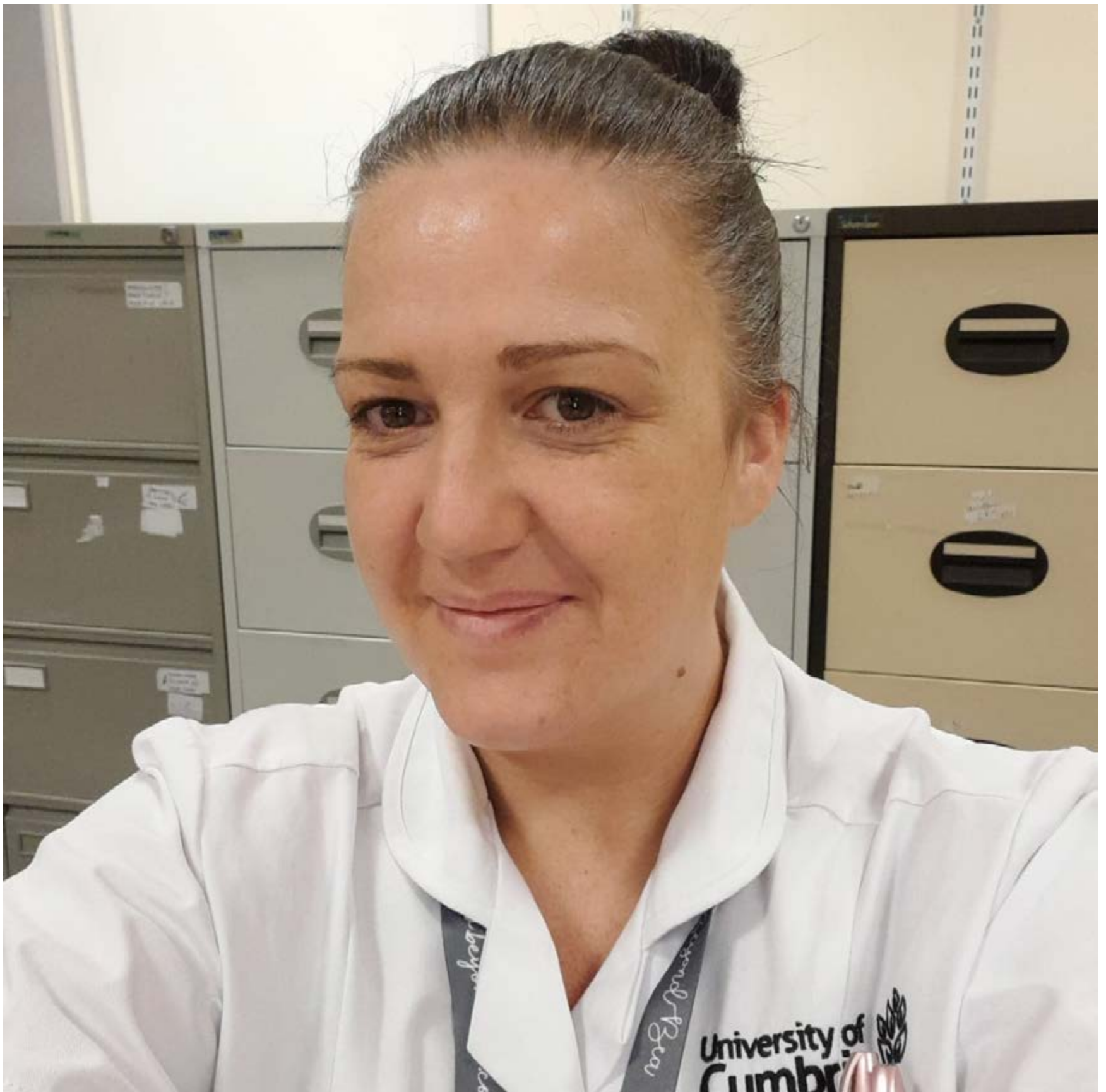


“One of the reasons why I chose the University of Cumbria was because as soon as I visited an open day, I instantly felt a positive, community atmosphere. Being surrounded by so many creative people felt so inspiring and really got me excited about the potential of studying here.

Lindsay Jayes has graduated in 2025 with a BSc (Hons) Midwifery degree. Lindsay’s journey to becoming a midwife has been shaped by the amazing friendships she’s made, her tremendous personal growth, and the enriching opportunities and support she’s received along the way.



“Reflecting upon my degree, I’m able to look back on some of the amazing things that I have been privileged to experience. This includes the amazing sisterhood that developed within the cohort, realising I can achieve things that I didn’t think possible, and the fantastic support from tutors, navigating me through academia with kindness and understanding.

“My favourite experience from my degree, apart from the privilege of caring for the many women on placement, has to be the opportunities that I have been given – such as becoming a student council member for NHS England and getting involved in numerous projects, in addition to becoming a trainer for Make Every Contact Count for mental health.

“I have been extremely lucky to have been offered a job within the trust at which I trained, which I am both nervous and very excited about. I will always hold this chosen path close to my heart and I am forever thankful to everyone I met along the way.”



OUR RESEARCH, KNOWLEDGE EXCHANGE AND TEACHING

Our teaching is led by practice, industry and research-informed academics. We offer flexible learning options, work experience opportunities and a safe space for critical challenge and experimentation. And through our academic institutes, centres and networks, research and knowledge exchange are an integral part of what we do at the University of Cumbria.

Building upon more than 150 years' of higher education and established in 2007, our university's reputation for research excellence and innovation is growing and will be a catalyst for prosperity locally, nationally and internationally. Research themes are focused on key areas including health and wellbeing, environment and geography, education and outdoor learning, creative practice, business, leadership and visitor economy and more.



Supporting our region, we are working closely with partners on major research innovations and projects that are recognised nationally. For instance, the £4.8m Cumberland Health Determinants Research Collaboration (HDRC) that has been live since January 2024 with our university as the primary academic partner working closely with Cumberland Council.

Our Centre for National Parks and Protected Areas (CNPPA) was a founding signatory to the Protected and Conserved Areas Joint Statement (PCAJS) at COP26 in Glasgow. This is a global statement signed by several international national park organisations, government departments and the International Union for Conservation of Nature's World Commission for Protected Areas (IUCN-WCPA).

In 2025, the Pears Cumbria School of Medicine Research Hub was launched. Over the next three years, the hub will fund collaborative projects between the university and NHS partners, in addition to supporting nursing, midwifery, and allied health professionals to develop their research skills. The hub is funded by an award from the Imperial NIHR BioMedical Research Centre.



Our knowledge exchange programmes utilise our academic expertise for real world benefit and as we look to the future, we are committed to growing the quality of research conducted by our staff by continuing to actively participate in the 'Research Excellence Framework' (REF).

This is the system for assessing the quality of research in UK higher education institutions and our research in allied health, social sciences, geography and environment, business, art and design, and education. As part of the latest REF2021, 42 per cent of our research has been independently rated as 'internationally excellent' or 'world leading', including 7.7 per cent rated in the highest category of 4*. Also, 54 per cent of our overall research impact has been independently rated as 'internationally excellent' or 'world leading'.

Another nationally recognised measure of quality is the proportion of academic staff who have gained Fellowship of the Higher Education Academy (HEA), now known as Advance HE. We have 73 per cent of our staff recognised by Advance HE as HEA Fellows, while 78 staff hold Senior HEA Fellowships. We also have two Principal HEA Fellows.



AND MOST IMPORTANTLY, OUR STUDENTS

Our students continue to be at the heart of everything we do, and we work hard to ensure their experience is the best it can be. Over 4,000 students achieve their academic awards each year, a figure that delivers immense satisfaction to us all. These skilled professionals enter the workplace or continue to study towards higher degrees. Many choose to remain in Cumbria, north Lancashire and London, contributing to the economic success and regeneration of our communities, applying the knowledge they have acquired to their new roles in the public and private sectors.

A great deal of our success arises from the commitment and dedication of the staff who work diligently to ensure that our students are at the very heart of our business. We strive to inspire all those who study at the University of Cumbria to make their mark professionally and become active and engaged citizens within their communities.



We remain fiercely proud of our long history through our legacy institutions of preparing students for work and life.

We are continuing their endeavours and helping our students to achieve personal and professional potential wherever and however they choose to do so, be it as a school/college leaver or a mature student taking a step into higher education; an employee furthering their career through continuing professional development or postgraduate opportunities; or those who desire flexible learning opportunities online or part-time.

Through our passion, ambition and collaborations, it remains our goal to make sure our students and our communities have the confidence and capability to seize opportunities and realise their potential.

Our university can look forward with much optimism to advancing with staff, students, partners and key stakeholders. We continue to deliver these valuable objectives and outcomes, and to witnessing the achievement of even greater reputational success, reinforcing our position as a mature, established institution.

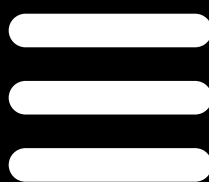

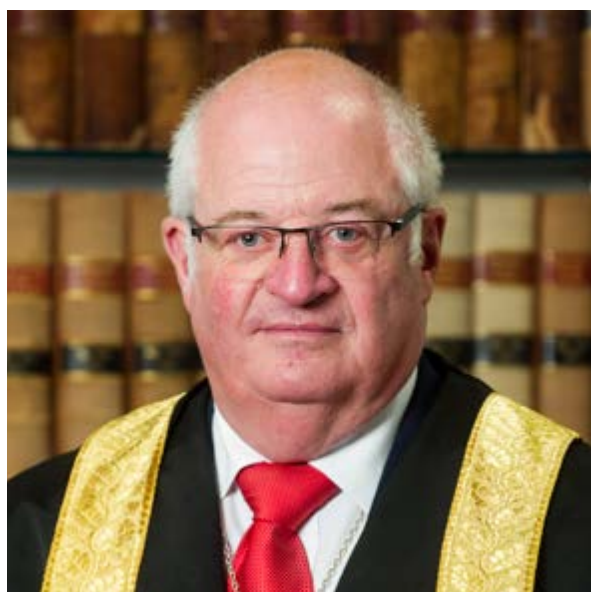

Let us aspire and achieve

The University Motto.

Following a survey of staff opinion as to the desired sentiments which should comprise a motto for the university in July 2007, the university's Board of Directors determined at its inaugural meeting on 1 August 2007 what the motto of the University of Cumbria should be.





THE MACE

The symbol of authority of our university, the Mace is an elegant, modern and thought-provoking design, which has nevertheless been crafted using traditional silversmithing techniques. As a design object, the Mace itself incorporates symbolism reflective of our university at the point of its inauguration.



The foot of the Mace depicts the seal of the university, a white Parnassus flower encircling a red rose, cut from silver sheet and carved as a cut card pictorial. The marriage of the two county floral symbols is a fitting reflection of the origins and location of our university.

This theme is developed through the three twisting spirals which comprise the central shaft of the Mace, and which symbolise the strength of a single unified whole borne out of three different strands.

The spiral has a pair of gilded collars with stars carved into them. The stars have been used firstly to represent aspiration, which is part of the motto of our university, and secondly to constitute a direct link with Carlisle Cathedral, where many academic ceremonies have been held, and where the inauguration ceremony took place.

As a lasting memorial of the inauguration, the concave part of the foot bears an inscription carved very deeply into the silver: The University of Cumbria Inauguration 2007.



The three spirals of the Mace culminate in a fluid and organic shape that is capable of multiple interpretation, being at once both bud-like, reflecting the birth of the new university, and flame-like, representing a torch of knowledge.

The shape is deliberately ambiguous, and others may see in it spiritual or creative import. The spirals are finished on the inside with a brightly hammered finish, and gilded to refract subtle glimmers of light, like the shimmering of water or the flashing of flames, giving life to the Mace and promise for the future.

THE GRANT OF ARMS

Following approval by Garter King of Arms, this Grant of Arms has been bestowed on the University of Cumbria by the English King of Arms.

The Coat of Arms includes a number of heraldic features which reflect the status, character and background of our university. The importance of Cumbria is significant in the design. The supporters, a ram and a stag, are reflective of the animals of Cumbria; the white Parnassus flower is the county flower of Cumbria; the blue wavy band in the crest symbolises the sea on the coast of Cumbria; and the lakes represent the Lake District. The university's historic links with Lancashire are reflected in the two red roses around the necks of the supporters.

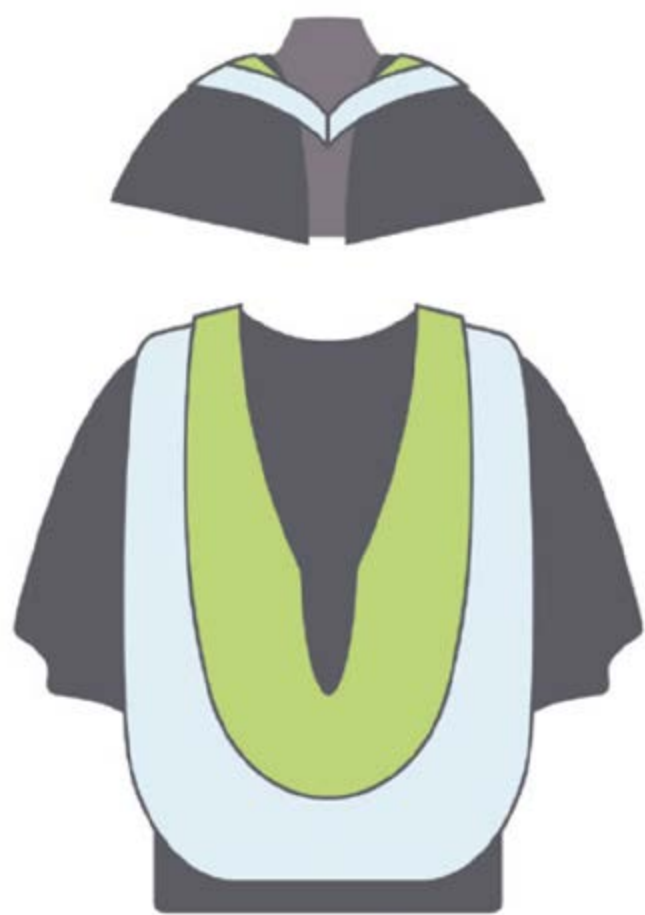


The academic nature of the organisation is signified by the torch of knowledge held aloft in the crest. The objectives of our university, in relation to the importance we attach both to our Christian values and to our creative traditions, are reflected in the inclusion on the shield of the jewelled bishops' mitres and the crossed artists' brushes.

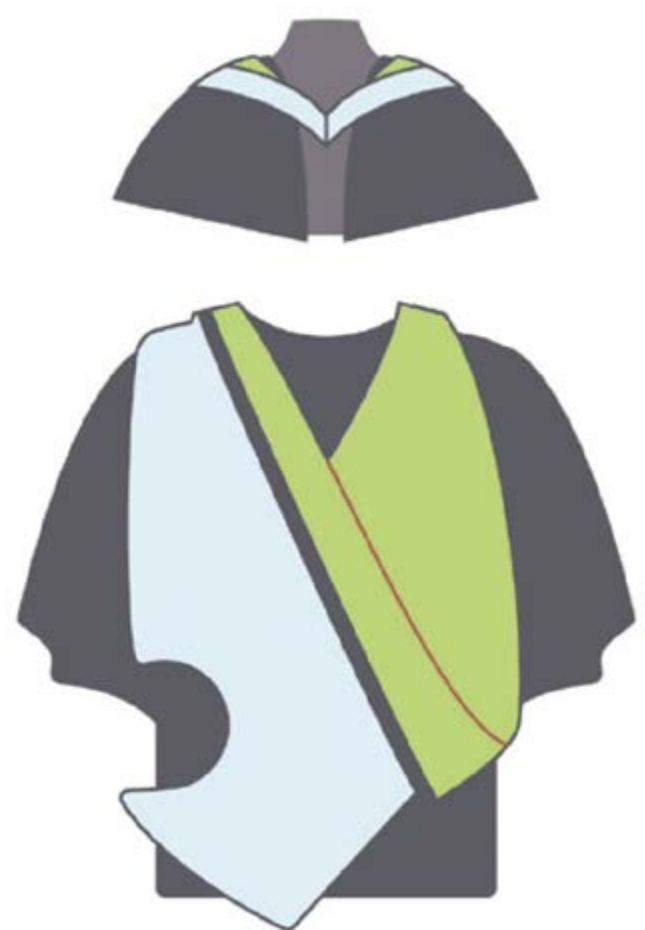
Surrounding the shield and around the necks of the supporters are twisted ropes, which depict the entwining together of the different strands which have come together to form a single university. The beech leaves depicted alongside the torch of knowledge are heraldically reminiscent of our university logo. The stars on the blue strip are, at the same time, symbols of the aspiration to which university members are exhorted in the motto, but also act as a reminder of our university's link with Carlisle Cathedral, where stars feature prominently on the bright blue ceiling.



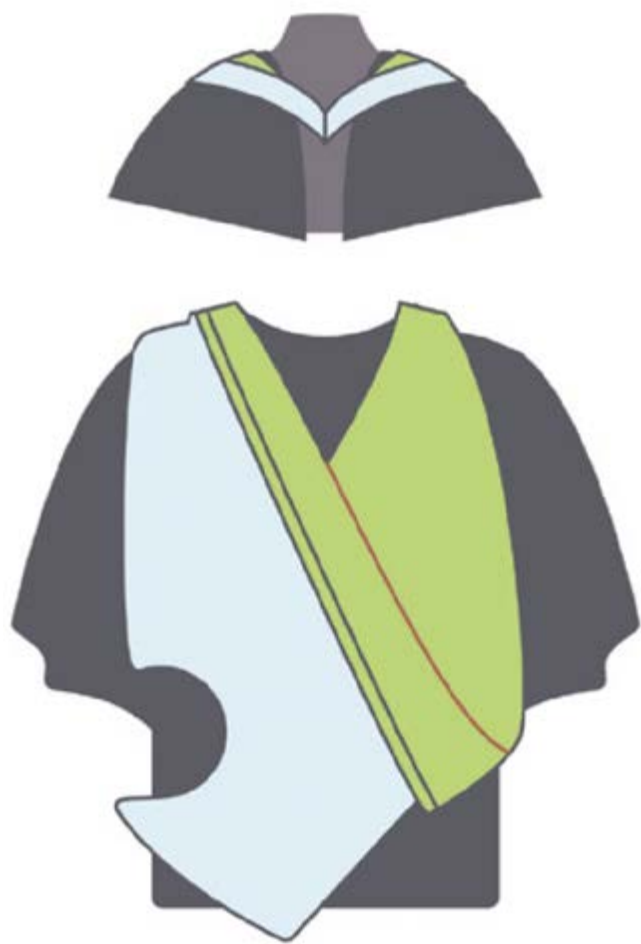

Here's Biomedical Science graduate Lisa Irving's experience of using the Careers & Employability Service

With one-to-one help from a Careers Adviser, Lisa started thinking about herself as



a scientist — she discarded her old CV and discovered how to create a new one that better showcased the many skills and knowledge gained from her science degree. With renewed confidence, a first-class degree and a fit-for-purpose CV, Lisa started approaching employers, finally securing work in a pharmacy. Whilst this was not her dream job, the experience proved invaluable, and Lisa started applying for laboratory roles.

After a couple of unsuccessful interviews, and a third one looming, she decided to book a practice interview with the Careers Service. Here is what she had to say afterwards:

For your first postgraduate award, you could receive as much as a 20 per cent discount on taught courses, or 10 per cent on research degrees. This is for awards of up to a maximum of 180 credits and does not apply to PGCE students.

International students will be entitled to the same absolute discount (not percentage) as home and EU students.

To receive this discount, you must have previously studied at the University of Cumbria as an undergraduate in the last five years and achieved an award of 120 credits minimum, as well as meet the relevant entry requirements for postgraduate study. Accreditation of Prior Learning charges are not included in this discount.
