More than just a medical school, the Pears Cumbria School of Medicine is a place to make a difference.

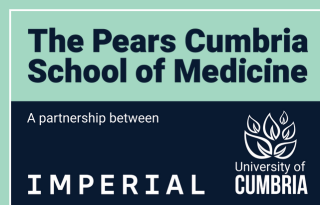
Our mission is to improve health outcomes for the people of Cumbria by training doctors who are committed to serving the needs of their local community.

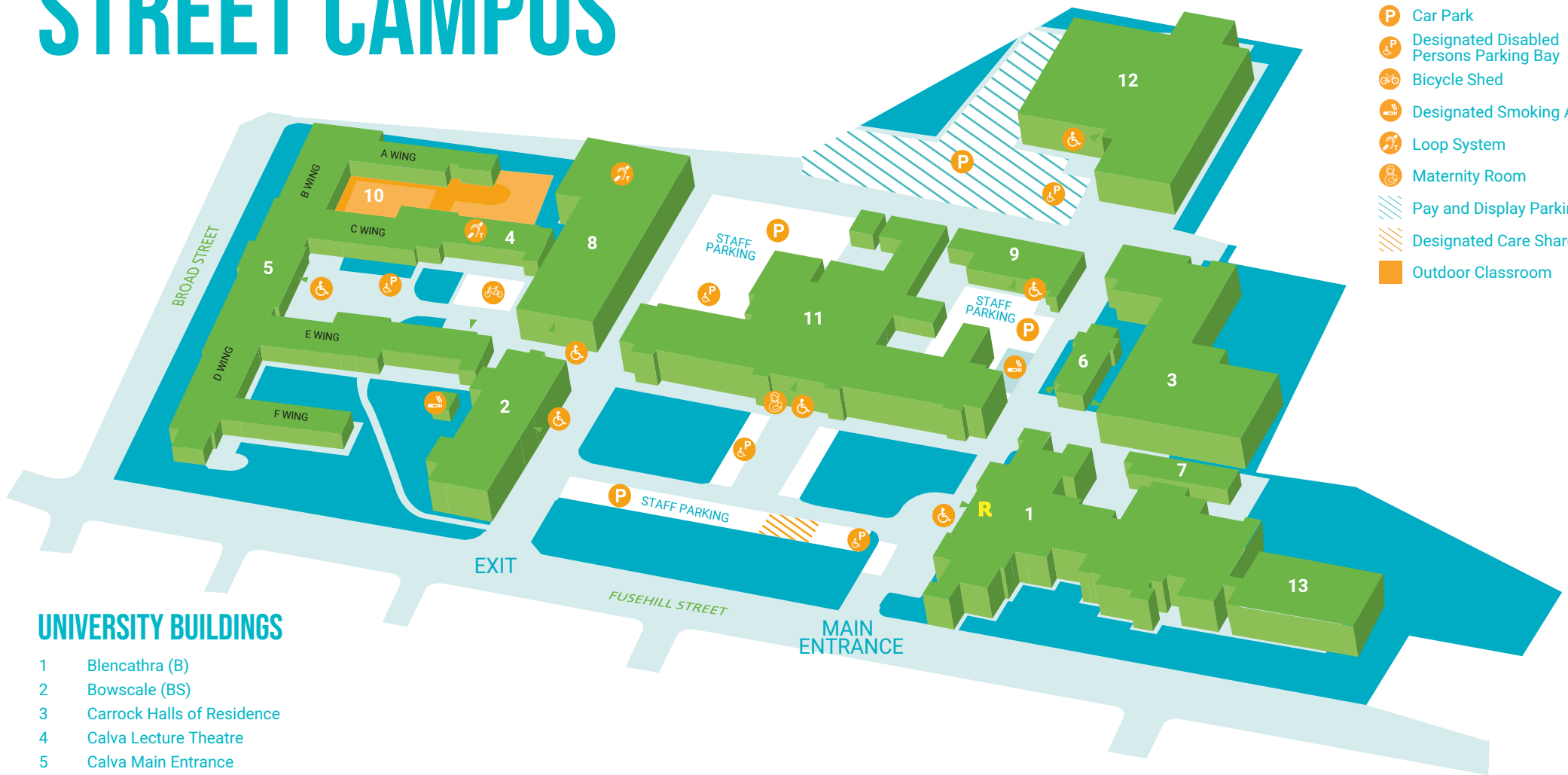
