


HOW TO LINK CONTENT TYPES IN PURE

Pure has been designed to enable **relationships** to be created between content types, meaning the various inputs and outputs of a project can be associated with each other. This creates a broader picture of research activity at the individual, Institute, Research Centre and University levels.

The templates for each content type include a section for adding relationships. Click on the “+” button of the content type that you want to link to and start typing to search for the specific record.
