

Barrow Learning Quarter

Cumbria is home to a thriving and advanced manufacturing hub, with our Barrow campus set to build on this by delivering degree programmes that are aligned with the needs of local employers, including manufacturing, cyber security and logistics.

With the increasing integration of computer technologies and automation in the workplace, there is growing demand for skilled manufacturing engineers in the region. To meet this need, academics at the University of Cumbria have worked in partnership with BAE Systems to design degree-level programmes for September 2024 entry. These courses will allow for a joined-up approach between education and industry, offering graduates exciting employment opportunities within the community.

Our Barrow campus, adjacent to the BAE Systems Submarine Skills and Knowledge site, will be positioned at the heart of the Barrow Learning Quarter. In recognition of Barrow's historic and ongoing involvement in the marine and defence industry, the building's design will echo the shape of a submarine.

Carlisle






Lancaster

Your Living Expenses

The cost of living as a student will vary greatly depending on your needs and personal lifestyle choices. One of the most expensive costs is your accommodation. Generally speaking, living expenses in the North West where most of our campuses are based, tends to be lower than other places in the UK.

A recent survey conducted by Student Crowd 2022, placed Carlisle 4th out of 70 cities as one of the most affordable Cities in the UK for student accommodation.

HEALTH & WELL-BEING

The Centre for Research in Health & Society (CRIHS) contributes towards the positive transformation of health and social outcomes, driving excellence in research, evaluation, scholarship, and practice.



ENVIRONMENT AND GEOGRAPHY

Led by the Centre of National Parks and Protected Areas (CNPPA), our research addresses complex local and global challenges and enables us to develop innovative practices that enhance landscapes and communities.

COURSE TYPES

Programmes of Study

The programmes of study offered by the University at postgraduate level can be divided into four main groups.

POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA & CERTIFICATE

Diplomas and Certificates are Level 7 qualifications that are valued at two-thirds or one-third of a traditional master's, respectively, and take less time to complete. Some courses may provide the option to top up Diplomas and Certificates to a master's level qualification at a later date.

PGCE

Want to teach your passion? Equivalent to 60 credits of a master's degree and typically lasting one year, a Postgraduate Certificate in Education (PGCE) prepares you to teach your subject in a classroom.

MASTER'S DEGREE

As a complete Level 7 qualification, studying a master's degree provides the opportunity to further explore an area of interest or take the next step towards a doctorate. Both taught and research courses will increase employability.

PHD

As the highest level of qualification, a doctorate degree offers students the opportunity to make a significant contribution to their field of study and collaborate with others to conduct and publish a piece of research.
