<b>Additional Costs</b>	
<p>All students need to be aware that they will incur additional costs whilst on programme. The list below will provide you with an overview of additional costs.</p> <p>Books are reviewed annually and are therefore subject to change, course welcome information will provide you with an indicative list for the year.</p>	
<b>Books and Journals</b>	
<p>All books and journals required for study, as detailing in the essential or recommended readings lists for each module, are available on loan (hard copy or e-book/journal) from the University Library at your chosen campus. Policing students may find it useful to buy a personal, up to date, copy of the 'Blackstone's Handbook for Policing Students', which retails at approximately £40.</p>	
<b>Stationery</b>	
<p>Students only require basic note-taking stationery for lectures and other learning activities.</p>	
<b>Clothing and Equipment</b>	
<p>No specific clothing or equipment is required for the BSc in Professional Policing. Students are encouraged to consider applying to join their local Special Constabulary (and are supported in this process). The Constabulary will supply all uniform and equipment needed for police duties, although the trainee Special Constable will be expected to buy their own boots in the first instance. Most Special Constabularies will usually reimburse this cost, up to a permissible maximum (which can vary, Force to Force). Special Constables are also allowed to claim back their travel and subsistence costs, when on duty (and in line with any specific Force policies and procedures).</p>	
<b>Field Trips</b>	
<p>Any field trips undertaken during the course will be on a no-cost basis (other than drinks, snacks etc.)</p>	
<b>Other</b>
