<p>Each module references essential and recommended reading in the form of books and journals. These are all available through library services. There is no requirement to purchase copies. This would be a personal choice.</p>	
<b>Stationery</b>	
<p>Stationery for your own personal use (pens, papers and folders, etc.).</p> <p>Whilst you will choose how much you need, expect to pay around £30 - £40 per year for these.</p> <p>Where the course has a requirement for you to produce materials, for example posters, it is acceptable to do this in electronic format thereby negating any cost.</p>	
<b>Clothing and Equipment</b>	
<p>No specialist requirements.</p>

<p>Field trips as part of the published curriculum will be provided at a no cost basis. Any other such events would be optional the choice as to whether to attend would be personal.</p>
