

Additional Costs

All students need to be aware that they will incur additional costs whilst on programme. The list below will provide you with an overview of additional costs. Books are reviewed annually and are therefore subject to change, course welcome information will provide you with an indicative list for the year.

Course:	Criminology (with pathways)
Books and Journals	All appropriate text books are made available through the University library, where possible through e-books to aid the ease of use. If students do wish to purchase their own copies they can, but this is not a requirement for access to the programme. The university also provides access to a wide range of academic journals without cost to students with many such academic articles now being made freely available via 'OpenAccess'.
Stationery	<p><i>Students will incur costs for stationery and printing and other basic materials whilst on course and should budget accordingly. Where specifics are required they will be detailed below but items denoted are an outline rather than indicative list.</i></p> <p>Stationery for your own personal use (pens, papers and folders, etc.) - Whilst you will choose how much you need, expect to pay around £10 - £20 per year for these. Additionally, if you wish to print or scan materials for your personal use, then this can be carried out via the university's Multi-Function Devices (MFD) with costs varying depending on the type and size. Access to MFDs is via credit loaded onto your Cumbria Card and you should budget up to £20 a year for light use.</p>
Equipment	<p>No special equipment required. You may wish to purchase a USB Flash Drive for your own peace of mind and suitable drives (32Mb / 64Mb) are available for £7 - £15.</p> <p>While many students purchase USB / pen drives to save or back up their work, the University has adopted for students' access to Microsoft 'OneDrive' which allows documents and other computer files, up to 1Tb in total, to be stored in the 'OneDrive' cloud which allows access from any internet enabled device.</p> <p>Computers – fixed and laptops, loaded with the software (Microsoft Office365, Adobe Acrobat, Internet Explorer, etc.) you will require, are available free for students to use at various locations across the campus.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For students on the Criminology with Forensic Investigation pathway: you will need to purchase the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A Laboratory Coat (£15) A standard SD Memory Card (from £4 - £30, depending on capacity) CSI Polo Shirt (£10) • For students on the Criminology with Applied Psychology pathway the following are things you may wish to budget for: <p>You are encouraged to join the British Psychological Society as a student member. The standard cost to join as a student member is £25.</p> <p>You may wish to budget for a trip to one of the BPS Conferences, approximately £100 plus travel and accommodation costs of around £200 venue dependent.</p> <p>You may wish to join our UoC psychology society at an approximate cost of £10 per annum</p>
