| <p>The University library holds copies of core texts (including some as e-books accessible online). Books and Journals - Students may want to purchase their own books and therefore would need to spend approximately £100-£200 a year on text books. | <p>Stationery for your own personal use (pens, papers and folders, etc.). Whilst you will choose how much you need, expect to pay around £30 - £40 per year for these.</p> | |

| <p>A good pair of black sensible shoes & black socks– you will be doing a lot of standing and walking in placement so make sure your feet are comfortable – go for comfort over fashion for your uniform shoes! Approx. cost £35-90 You will need to purchase a blue / black thigh length coat to cover your uniform when you are required to wear it.
