EU/EEA Fees for 2021/22

If you are an EU/EEA or Swiss National with Settled or Pre-Settled Status in the UK you will still be eligible to pay Home fees and have access to Student Finance England tuition loans after 1st September 2021.

If you are an EU/EEA or Swiss National living overseas you will be classified as "Overseas" for fees purposes from 1st September 2021.

If you are an EU, EEA or Swiss national student starting at university in England on or after 1st August 2021 and you were not in the UK before 31st December 2020, you will no longer be eligible for UK Home fees status or have access to the Student Loans. You will need to apply for a visa under the new Student route.

The University of Cumbria wishes to support European students affected by the change in status through this transition period. We will award an (automatic) FEE REDUCTION SCHOLARSHIP to all eligible EU students starting their course with us in September 2021 or January 2022, which brings your fee into line with the fee paid by UK students. This will apply for the duration of your degree course.

To receive the EU Fee Reduction Scholarship, you must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Be classified as 'Overseas' for fees purposes
- Be an EU/EEA/Swiss national on 1 September (2021) before the start of the course

Changes to the eligibility of EU students for home fee status and financial support from Student Finance England have been confirmed in a Government Statement. These changes take effect from academic year 2021/22 entry. Exemptions apply to those who have settled or pre-settled status

under the EU Settlement Scheme, as well as Irish nationals, who may still be eligible for the UK tuition fee rate and associated financial support. Irish nationals should apply to Student Universal Support Ireland (SUSI).
