

You now become a member of our Alumni Association—an international network of approximately 77,000 former students. It will keep you




connected with Cumbria and with each other. Your successes will help inspire and motivate tomorrow's students and I offer my personal congratulations on your achievements.



LOOKING AHEAD

It is an exciting time for our university and for Cumbria.

In Carlisle, we continue to work with our partners - Cumberland Council and Borderlands Inclusive Growth Deal leaders - to advance our plans for our new £78 million Citadels campus.



Our new Barrow campus opens in September, which symbolises the growth plans for the town that we and our partners - including Brilliant Barrow and Team Barrow - are driving forward. We will deliver university-level programmes initially in Mechanical Engineering, Computer Science and Adult Nursing - with more to follow. At a time of significant transformation, shaping the future of Barrow into a university town will not only provide considerable opportunities for the town but also the wider region.

In August we will welcome students to Cumbria's first graduate-entry medical school, the Pears Cumbria School of Medicine, a unique partnership between University of Cumbria and Imperial College London.

The four-year, graduate-entry programme features a bespoke curriculum aligned with local healthcare planning and infrastructure, ensuring students gain the skills needed to contribute meaningfully to the NHS and their communities.

The school is also building a foundation for research that addresses regional health challenges and improves patient outcomes. The school is the result of a shared vision to educate medical professionals to serve communities in regions with the greatest need.





In September, the University of Cumbria International College will open to students. It offers a number of foundation, international year one and premaster's programmes from our Lancaster campus. International College students will then progress to the university's existing programmes across all campuses and will help bring a new generation of international students to Cumbria.

The opening of our Barrow site, medical school and International College, alongside the work being undertaken in Carlisle, are all key milestones in our university's strategy, purpose and mission alongside our growth and development during our 18-year journey to date.

As we look forward, we will continue to transform lives and livelihoods through learning, applied research and practice for now and for our future generations.

A recent graduate of our Outdoor Leadership course, Opal, who is from South Africa, is exploring all the incredible opportunities available to her in the UK.







OUR RESEARCH, KNOWLEDGE EXCHANGE AND TEACHING

Our teaching is led by practice, industry and research-informed academics. We offer flexible learning options, work experience opportunities and a safe space for critical challenge and experimentation. And through our academic institutes, centres and networks, research and knowledge exchange are an integral part of what we do at the University of Cumbria.

Building upon more than 150 years of higher education and established in 2007, our university's reputation for research excellence and innovation is growing and will be a catalyst for prosperity locally, nationally and internationally. Research themes are focused on key areas including health and wellbeing, environment and geography, education and outdoor learning, creative practice, business, leadership and visitor economy and more.



Supporting our region, we are working closely with partners on major research innovations and projects that are recognised nationally. For instance, the £4.8m Cumberland Health Determinants Research Collaboration (HDRC) that has been live since January 2024 with University of Cumbria as the primary academic partner working closely with Cumberland Council.

Our Centre for National Parks & Protected Areas (CNPPA) was a founding signatory to the Protected and Conserved Areas Joint Statement (PCAJS) at COP26 in Glasgow. This is a global statement signed by several international national park organisations, government departments and the International Union for Conservation of Nature's World Commission for Protected Areas (IUCN-WCPA).

In 2025, the Pears Cumbria School of Medicine Research Hub was launched. Over the next three years, the hub will fund collaborative projects between the University and NHS partners, in addition to supporting Nursing, Midwifery, and Allied Health Professionals to develop their research skills. The Hub is funded by an award from the Imperial NIHR BioMedical Research Centre.



Our knowledge exchange programmes utilise our academic expertise for real world benefit and as we look to the future, we are committed to growing the quality of research conducted by our staff by continuing to actively participate in the 'Research Excellence Framework' (REF).

This is the system for assessing the quality of research in UK higher education institutions and our research in allied health, social sciences, geography and environment, business, art and design, and education. As part of the latest REF2021, 42% of our research has been independently rated as internationally excellent' or 'world leading', including 7.7% rated in the highest category of 4*. 54% of our overall research impact has also been independently rated as 'internationally excellent' or 'world leading'.

Another nationally recognised measure of quality is the proportion of academic staff who have gained Fellowship of the Higher Education Academy(HEA), now known as Advance HE. 73% of our staff are recognised by Advance HE as HEA Fellows, while 78 staff hold Senior HEA Fellowships. We also have two Principal HEA Fellows.



AND MOST IMPORTANTLY, OUR STUDENTS

Our students continue to be at the heart of everything we do, and we work hard to ensure their experience is the best it can be. Over 4,000 students achieve their academic awards each year, a figure that delivers immense satisfaction to us all, reflecting as it does additional skilled professionals entering the workplace or continuing to higher degrees. Many choose to remain in Cumbria, north Lancashire and east London, contributing to the economic success and regeneration of our communities, applying the knowledge they have acquired to their new roles in the public and private sectors.

A great deal of our success arises from the commitment and dedication of the staff who work so hard to ensure that our students are at the very heart of our business. We strive to inspire all those who study at the University of Cumbria to make their mark professionally and become active and engaged citizens within their communities.




We remain fiercely proud of our long history through our legacy institutions of preparing students for work and life.

CARLISLE CATHEDRAL

Welcome to Carlisle Cathedral.

Carlisle Cathedral is a magnificent setting for one of the proudest days of your life, and you are most welcome as we celebrate with you today.



There has probably been a church on this site since the seventh century, when St Cuthbert is known to have visited Carlisle in AD 685. The oldest parts of the present building are the Norman south transept (inside the main door) and the surviving parts of the nave. They were part of the Augustinian Priory founded by Henry I in 1122. The Priory Church was made a cathedral in 1133, when the Diocese of Carlisle was created.

A pattern of daily prayer, music and hospitality continues to be the heartbeat of the Cathedral, and our bells chime for all across our city and county. We may not be the biggest of the English cathedrals, but dignity and intimacy combine here to delight those who enter our doors. The magnificent 58' high east window has some of the finest fourteenth-century 'Decorated' stone tracery in the country. And the spectacular, star-spangled ceiling – the creation of Owen Jones in the 1850s – lifts both eye and spirit. It's no wonder that visitors pause to marvel: here is an intimation of eternity, of times long past, and of all that is to come in God's loving purposes.


THE UNIVERSITY MOTTO

ASPIREMUS EFFICIAMUS

Let us aspire and achieve

The University Motto.

Following a survey of staff opinion as to the desired sentiments which should comprise a motto for the university in July 2007, the university's Board of Directors determined at its inaugural meeting on 1 August 2007 what the motto of the University of Cumbria should be.





THE MACE

The symbol of authority of the university, the Mace is an elegant, modern and thought-provoking design, which has nevertheless been crafted using traditional silversmithing techniques. As a design object, the Mace itself incorporates symbolism reflective of the university at the point of its inauguration.



The foot of the Mace depicts the seal of the university, a white Parnassus flower encircling a red rose, cut from silver sheet and carved as a cut card pictorial. The marriage of the two county floral symbols is a fitting reflection of the origins and location of the university.

This theme is developed through the three twisting spirals which comprise the central shaft of the Mace, and which symbolise the strength of a single unified whole borne out of three different strands.

The spiral has a pair of gilded collars with stars carved into them. The stars have been used firstly to represent aspiration, which is part of the motto of the university, and secondly to constitute a direct link with Carlisle Cathedral, where many academic ceremonies have been held, and where the inauguration ceremony took place.

As a lasting memorial of the inauguration, the concave part of the foot bears an inscription carved very deeply into the silver: The University of Cumbria Inauguration 2007.



The three spirals of the Mace culminate in a fluid and organic shape that is capable of multiple interpretation, being at once both bud-like, reflecting the birth of the new university, and flame-like, representing a torch of knowledge.

The shape is deliberately ambiguous, and others may see in it spiritual or creative import. The spirals are finished on the inside with a brightly hammered finish, and gilded to refract subtle glimmers of light, like the shimmering of water or the flashing of flames, giving life to the Mace and promise for the future.

THE GRANT OF ARMS

Following approval by Garter King of Arms, this Grant of Arms has been bestowed on the University of Cumbria by the English King of Arms.

The Coat of Arms includes a number of heraldic features which reflect the status, character and background of the university. The importance of Cumbria is significant in the design. The supporters, a ram and a stag, are reflective of the animals of Cumbria; the white Parnassus flower is the county flower of Cumbria; the blue wavy band in the crest symbolises the sea on the coast of Cumbria; and the lakes represent the Lake District. The University's historic links with Lancashire are reflected in the two red roses around the necks of the supporters.



The academic nature of the organisation is signified by the torch of knowledge held aloft in the crest. The objectives of the university, in relation to the importance it attaches both to its Christian values and to its creative traditions, are reflected in the inclusion on the shield of the jewelled bishops' mitres and the crossed artists' brushes.

Surrounding the shield and around the necks of the supporters are twisted ropes, which depict the entwining together of the different strands which have come together to form a single university. The beech leaves depicted alongside the torch of knowledge are heraldically reminiscent of the university logo. The stars on the blue strip are, at the same time, symbols of the aspiration to which university members are exhorted in the motto, but also act as a reminder of the university's link with Carlisle Cathedral, where stars feature prominently on the bright blue ceiling.





Here's Biomedical Sciences graduate Lisa Irving's experience of using the Careers & Employability Service
